"From Vision to Implementation: Shaping Policies to Boost Circular Bio-Based Transition" closing event

21th of March 2025, 11:00 - 12:30 CET, Online

	The workshop is organised in the context of the <u>SUSTRACK project</u> , which is aimed at supporting policymakers to develop pathways to replace fossil and carbon-intensive systems with sustainable circular and bio-based systems. This event is the last appointment of the "From Vision to Implementation: Shaping Policies to Boost Circular Bio-Based Transition" series of workshops, taking place between February and March 2025 and involving policy experts from the four sectors of interest: chemical, textile, plastics and construction. The aim is to share and further discuss the outcomes of the sectoral workshops, in which the draft policy recommendations for industrial and political stakeholders were jointly elaborated and developed.

Objectives	 Present a summary of the main takeaways collected during the series of sectoral workshops "From Vision to Implementation: Shaping Policies to Boost Circular Bio-Based Transition". These events involved more than 150 stakeholders, hosted 10 key note speakers, and resulted in a broad discussion about strengths and weaknesses of SUSTRACK proposed policy options, as well as further possible policy opportunities/approaches from diverse perspectives, including policy, research, industry, and civil society; Present an overview of: SUSTRACK methods and tools to monitor the transition, available to support stakeholders' actions boosting the circular bio-based transition; The key outcomes from the 11 SUSTRACK selected case studies in chemical, textile, plastics and construction sectors.
